WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, **Vapes**, fireworks, water guns, or any kind of weapon
- Items that may be used for pranks such as water balloons, shaving cream, silly string, etc. Pranks are not allowed at camp. Parents will be charged for any damages or issues related to clean up.

DRESS CODE

- Make sure your student does NOT pack anything that:
 - Advertises alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs.
 - Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person.
 - Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations.
 - Has spaghetti/small straps or open back, except for sleepwear.
 - Is excessively short or tight fitting.
 - Has writing or lettering on the caboose/backside/bottom/fanny (you get the picture).
- While at camp, we ask students to:
 - Wear modest shorts (when hands are extended to the back or the front, fingertips must touch fabric).
 - Girls bathing suits should be a one piece or tankini covering midriff. If bathing suit is a bikini, T Shirt must be worn.
