"What Does It Mean to Gain the Whole World and Lose Your Own Soul?"

A. The Church has to put priority on the value of the human soul.

(Read Matthew 16:21-27) (Key V.26)

- 21 From that time Jesus began to show to His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day.
- 22 Then Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him, saying, "Far be it from You, Lord; this shall not happen to You!"
- 23 But He turned and said to Peter, "Get behind Me, Satan! You are an offense to Me, for you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men."
- 24 Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.
- 25 For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it.
- 26 For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?
- 27 For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.

B. "Man became a LIVING BEING, SOUL, CREATURE, PERSON"

(Read Genesis 2:7)

- 7 And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.

(Read Jeremiah 38:16)

- 16 So Zedekiah the king swore secretly to Jeremiah, saying, "As the Lord lives, who made our very souls, I will not put you to death, nor will I give you into the hand of these men who seek your life."

C. To be made to resemble God it makes sense that the soul of man is vitally important to God.

(Read Genesis 1: 26-28)

- 26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."
- 27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.
- 28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

(Read John 3:16-17)

16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

(Read Ephesians 2:8-9)

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.

(Read 2 Corinthians 5:17)

17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

Summary: The human soul is not a throw away item. The soul of man is precious to God. Therefore, there is no profit to lose one's soul for the temporary things of this world. Just not worth it.

Application to the Unsaved: Today, you need to stop and ask God to open your eyes, heart to the truth and make salvation plain. Your soul is worth the commitment. Today you can be saved and know it.

Application to the Saved: Live everyday thanking God, telling others, and making commitments to God's Kingdom work.
